1) Find a clinic that will receive	<p>It is important you find a clinic that will receive the material</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the material involves donor eggs and/or donor sperm, you must ensure that the clinic can handle it. We have experienced that in some countries there may be problems with this; for example, that the egg donor must register in the national register or that embryos with sperm donor whose pregnancy quota is closed in the country concerned cannot be received.</li> <li>• Get a contact person and an email address for the clinic.</li> </ul>
2) Send a mail to <a href="mailto:Transport@trianglen.dk">Transport@trianglen.dk</a>	<p>Here you must inform us about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The clinic's name, address, contact person and email address.</li> <li>• That the clinic has confirmed that it can receive your material with Danish egg donor and/or sperm donor ID - if your material involves donor egg and/or donor sperm.</li> </ul>
3) We contact the clinic	<p>The clinic must be approved by us, as it must meet specific quality requirements (The EU Tissue Directive) for us to send the material. For example, we need to make sure that the clinic has a quality management system ensuring traceability and can handle the thawing procedure.</p>
4) You are to sign a document	<p>We will send you a document for signing, confirming that you want the transport to the clinic in question.</p>
5) You forward documents to the clinic	<p>Once we have confirmed that the clinic meets the quality requirements, the clinic abroad must approve Trianglen and the material, which for example includes information about your (and possibly donors) virus tests and information about the material (e.g., the development and score of the blastocysts) and the marking of the straws in which the material is cryopreserved. This information is collected in a document that we send to you. You shall pass this on to the receiving clinic. Identical documents are attached to the transport itself.</p>
6) You contact a transport company	<p>Once the clinics have approved the transport, you can start the transport.
